

TYPES OF GAMING & 100% SMOKEFREE COVERAGE BY STATE

The following grid indicates which type of commercial gaming each state has and whether or not it is protected by a 100% smokefree law.

- ** Indicates tribally owned and operated casinos exist in state; however, these are sovereign entities and not reflected in the map or chart
- "Other"** Includes video lottery terminals (VLTs) and/or keno and/or pull-tabs and/or card clubs
