

Percent of U.S. State Populations Covered by 100% Smokefree Air Laws

This table lists the percent of each state's population covered by 100% smokefree air laws enacted by both the state (see *state* rows) and local municipalities (see *local* rows). Only ordinances and laws currently in effect are listed in the table.

Note: Only municipalities and states with ordinances or laws that do not allow smoking in attached bars or separately ventilated rooms and do not allow exemptions based on size, hours of operation, or age of admittance are listed here.

- **Puerto Rico**, a U.S. Commonwealth, enacted a 100% smokefree law for all workplaces, restaurants, bars and casinos, which went into effect on March 2, 2007. The law covers 100% of the Commonwealth's population.
- **South Dakota** enacted a 100% smokefree restaurant, bar, and gaming facilities law, which was scheduled to go into effect on July 1, 2009, but which has been suspended by a referendum placing the law on the ballot in November 2010, and which will not go into effect unless approved by the voters.
- **Michigan** enacted a 100% workplace, restaurant, and bar law, which is scheduled to go into effect May 1, 2010.
- **Wisconsin** enacted a 100% workplace, restaurant, and bar law, which is scheduled to go into effect July 5, 2010.

Altogether, there are 17,622 municipalities covered by either local, state, or commonwealth 100% smokefree laws in at least one of the three main categories (workplaces, restaurants, and bars). Since some have 100% smokefree coverage in more than one category, the numbers are not mutually exclusive. Due to the possibility of overlap, it can be confusing to understand what each of the figures on our lists mean.
